Did you know that Deer Creek Middle School recycles paper?

Abitibi Paper Retriever is partnered with Deer Creek Middle School to be YOUR source for paper recycling. By recycling paper, not only do you save water and energy, but Deer Creek Middle School makes money!

You can put all your magazines, mail, newspapers and office papers in the green and yellow bin in our parking lot. Please do not include cardboard or phone books. The paper is recycled by Abitibi and used to make new newspaper. The entire process, from the time our bin is picked up to the time the newspaper is printed, only takes two weeks!

Even better, we get PAID for every ton Deer Creek Middle School recycles. We can use this money for new equipment, needed repairs and special events. Recycling one ton of paper, or about 1 full bin, saves over 7,000 gallons of water, 390 gallons of oil and 60 lbs of air emissions.
